► *Bottles, Cans & Paper*

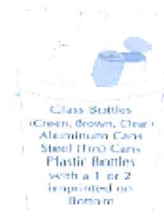
Place the following items in a reusable container labeled "RECYCLABLES".

Glass Bottles (Green, Brown, Clear)

Aluminum Cans

Steel (Tin) Cans

Plastic Bottles, Jars and Jugs with a  (PETE), , , , , or  (Other) imprinted on bottom



Place all used paper in a paper or plastic bag or tie used paper in bundles and place curbside with other recyclables.

Newspaper

Magazines

Office Paper

Junk Mail

Flat board (cereal boxes, soda boxes, non-corrugated cardboard)



What *Not* to Recycle

PAPER - food contaminated or plastic coated paper and cardboard; pizza boxes, plates, towels and napkins.

GLASS -light bulbs, mirrors, drinking glasses, Pyrex™

ALUMINUM -foil, pie plates.

PLASTIC -motor oil and charcoal lighter fluid bottles, toys, tableware, straws, six pack rings, laundry baskets, and storage containers.

PLASTIC BAGS – Can be recycled at your local supermarket
