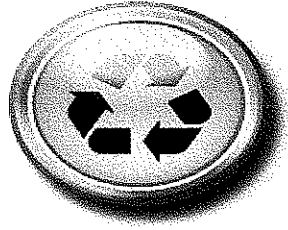

FLUORESCENT BULB RECYCLING

Dougllass Township Montgomery County does not accept fluorescent light bulbs for disposal. All fluorescent bulbs contain mercury and therefore should be recycled rather than placed in a landfill. For more information about fluorescent light bulb recycling, visit the Environmental Protection Agencies website.

Several area retailers accept CFL bulbs for recycling with no purchase nessecary. Look for collection bins at store entrances or ask about fluorescent bulb recycling at the service desk. Look for fluorescent bulb recycling programs at home improvement stores and at businesses that sell light fixtures and light bulbs.

Residents can bring spent fluorescent bulbs to any Montgomery County Household Hazardous Waste collection event scheduled throughout the year.

Businesses, institutions or residents generating large amounts of fluorescent bulbs should contact bulb recyclers directly for service. Attached is a list of fluorescent bulb recyclers.
