## **Informational Public Meeting: Boyertown Landfill HSCA Site**

**When:** Wednesday, December 10, 2025, 6:00 pm

**Where:** The Gilbertsville Fire and Rescue Company (1456 E Philadelphia Ave, Gilbertsville, PA 19525).

The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is hosting an informational public meeting to discuss DEP's investigation of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) in drinking water in the vicinity of the Boyertown Landfill HSCA Site located in Douglass Township, Montgomery County.

- In April 2023, following Pennsylvania's establishment of drinking water standards for two Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), DEP initiated a response to address drinking water contamination of private wells.
- In June 2024, DEP expanded the response to incorporate new federal drinking water standards for PFAS. DEP's investigation into potentially impacted drinking water wells is ongoing.
- During the public meeting, DEP plans to discuss the status of DEP's PFAS investigation and answer the public's questions related to the investigation.
- EPA will also provide an update on the status of the Site Inspection performed through its Superfund program.
