Project Overview

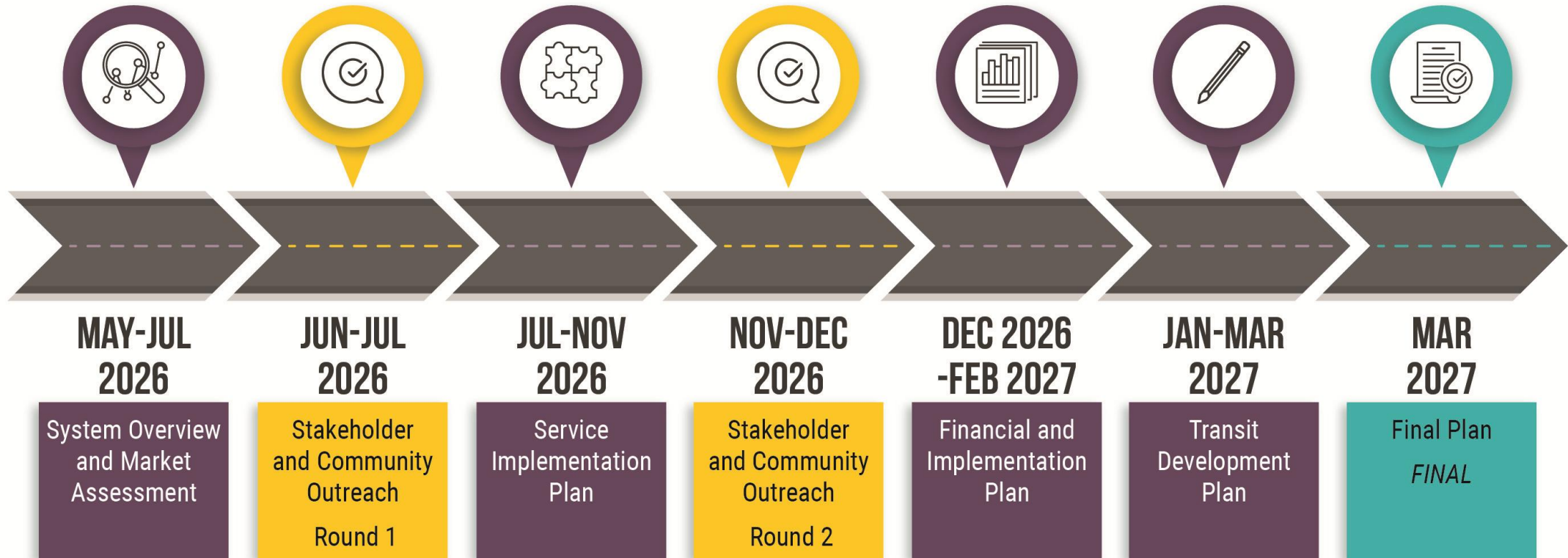


A Transit Development Plan (TDP) serves as a blueprint for the PART planning, operations, and capital needs over the next several years

It will include:

- Review current bus routes, schedules, and performance
- Identify gaps in service and unmet needs
- Recommendations for improved service (short- and long-term)
- Implementation and financial plan

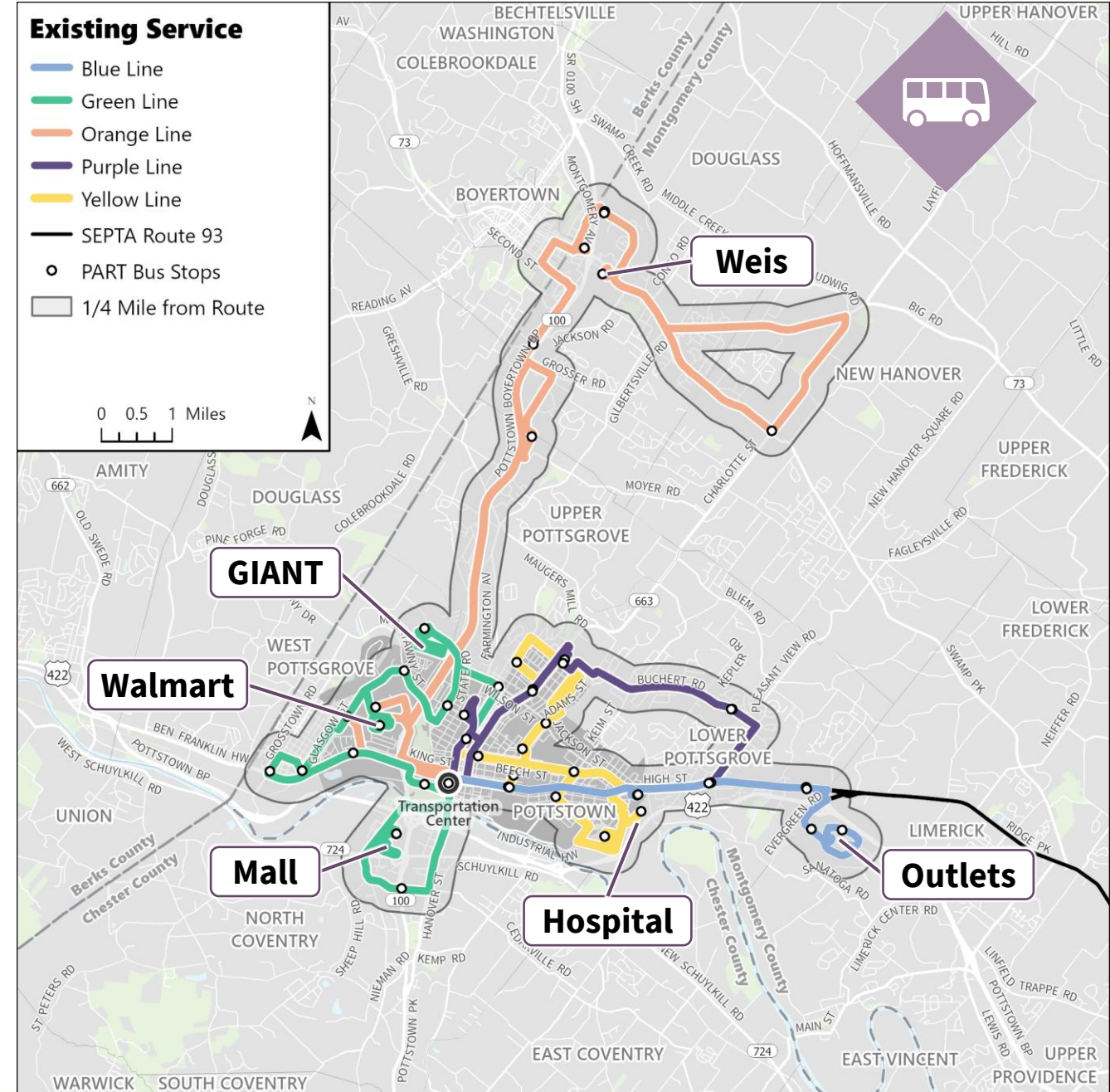

Transit Service Today

- Five PART bus routes
- Service on weekdays and Saturdays
 - Weekday: ~ 6:00 AM – 10:00 PM
 - Saturday: ~ 6:30 AM – 10:00 PM
- 60 minutes between buses (120 minutes on Orange Line)
- \$2.50 adult fare, plus discounted options
- ADA paratransit by reservation
- SEPTA Route 93 between Pottstown and Norristown Transit Center, 7 days a week

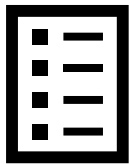
